Article II Parliamentary Procedure

Roberts Rules of Order shall be observed in all cases not provided for in the Constitution and Bylaws.

Article III Additions - Amendments

Section 1

No articles may be made a part of these Bylaws or Amendments hereafter adopted which are in conflict with Constitution and Bylaws of the State and National Association of Postal Supervisors.

Section 2

Amendments to the Constitution shall be presented in written or typed form to each member of the Branch before a regular meeting and voted upon by the membership at the next meeting, whether regular or at the call of the President of the Branch. Changes and amendments shall be adopted by simple majority or responding members. Responses can be written or as directed by presiding officer at a meeting.

Section 3

Any member wishing to be a paid delegate to State or National Conventions must be a member in good standing as determined by Branch Officers.
